In the first half of 2020, the <u>ESPON ACPA project</u> was finished. ACPA (Adapting European Cities to Population Ageing) was centered around policy challenges and effective solutions for European cities that are developing and implementing age-friendly programs. It investigated the effectiveness of policies and initiatives to develop age-friendly cities and initiatives that support "ageing in place" in eight cities and city-regions. As a result, a final report together with a policy handbook, case study reports and sets of maps and figures are available to document the findings.

To capitalise on this, ESPON egtc is organising a conference week about population ageing together with Eurocities, AGE Platform Europe and the World Health Organisation. The week consists of a kick-off event, with a number of high-level speakers and experts, including vice president of the European Commission and Commissioner on Democracy and Demography Dubravka Šuica.
